Easter study

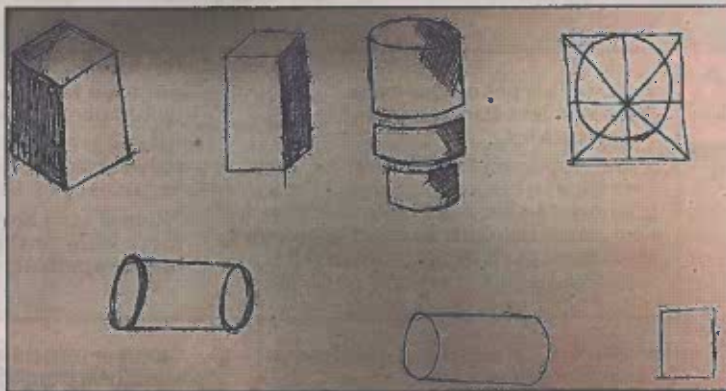
The school would like to thank the many staff who are giving up time this Easter to provide our students with opportunity to make progress in their courses.

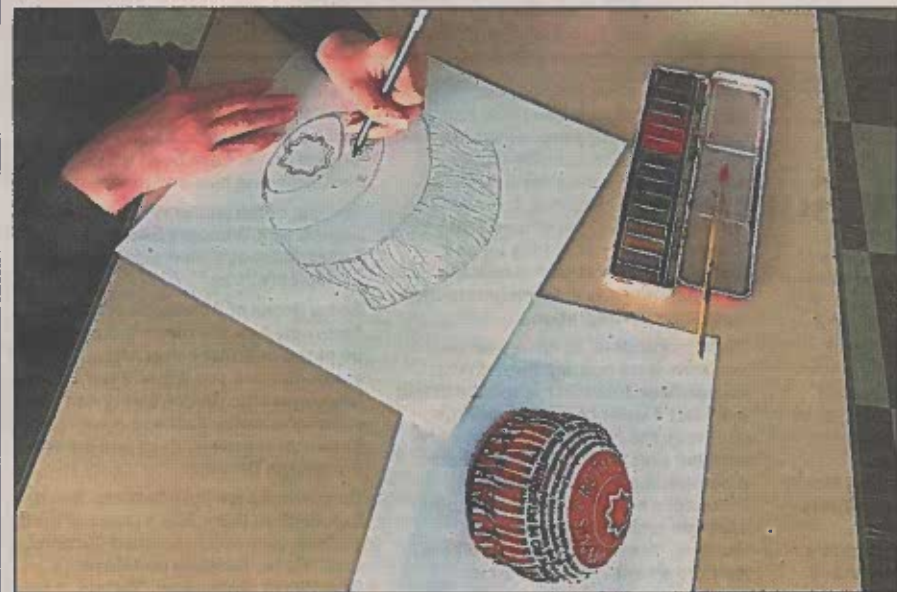

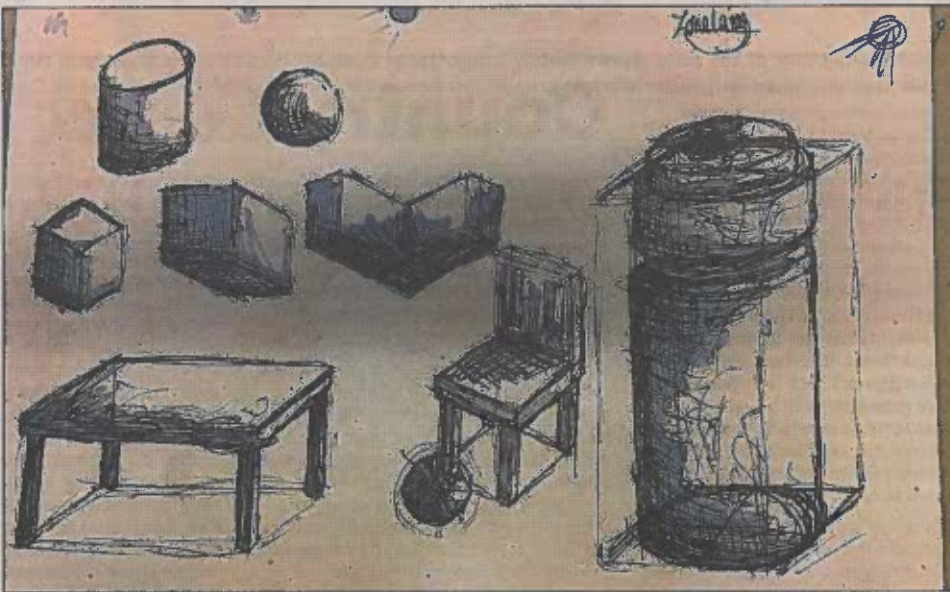
