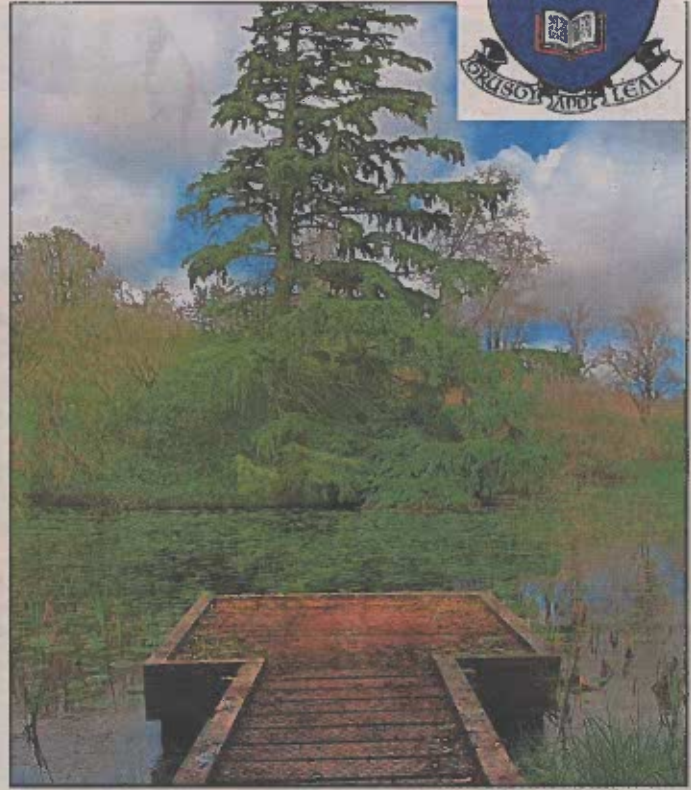

This year, our senior employability class started a small social enterprise called 'Only Plants', raising money for local charities, including Stable Life and The Harris Trust.

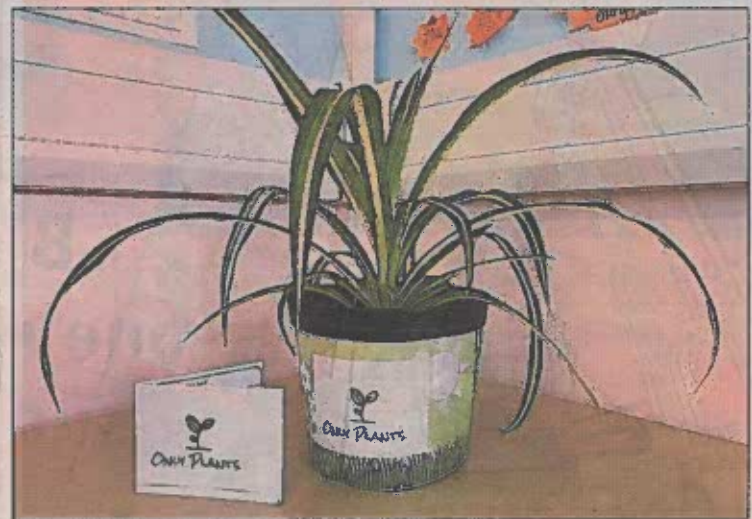
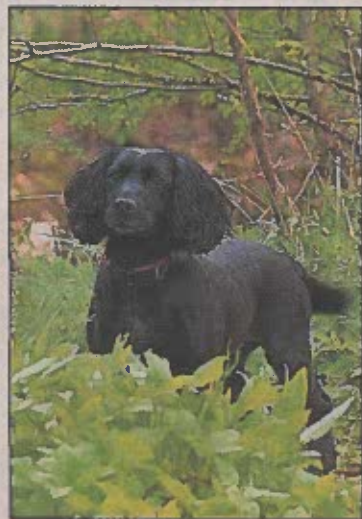
A range of items have been grown and sold such as courgettes, sweetcorn, sweetpeas, nasturtiums, polyanthus and gourds.
