selling a selection of veg plants after the coronation bank holiday. Available plants and prices will be posted on the Selkirk High horticulture page, school Facebook page and Instagram.

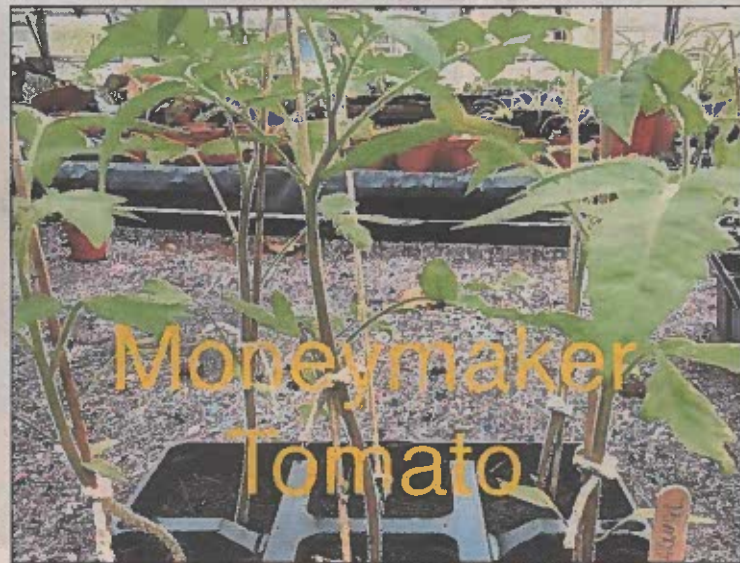
### Plant sale
