This session, there will be a mix of assessments: some will be more formal, in the hall and take place the first week after the Christmas holiday; assessments taken during class time; continuous evidence gathering throughout the year. The following timetables provide information of when set assessments will take place. Use the blank timetable at the back of this booklet to create your own assessment timetable.

Advice given to you by your subject teachers should help prepare you for these assessments. Please remember it is your responsibility to plan your study and be fully ready for all of your assessments as they allow both you and your teacher to see where you are currently in your learning and what specific next steps are needed.

The assessments will take place in different areas (e.g. normal classroom or gym hall), check locations carefully when creating your own timetable.

Please note the following when using this timetable:

- 1. Any students that require special arrangements to be made for assessments will be advised of the times and locations by Mr Lee/Miss Blair. These may differ from the main timetable.
- 2. Please take some time to read the information at the back of the booklet on assessment conduct. Invigilators that we use during the main exams will be conducting some of the assessments. The SQA take assessment conduct very seriously and it is important that we follow the guidance during these Winter Assessments to fully prepare you for the main exams in May.
- 4. Punctuality and attendance at all assessments are very important. If you are going to miss an assessment due to illness, please let the office or class teacher know.

The Winter assessments are a very important part of your qualifications. They allow you to judge your progress within a subject, find out what you know and what you still need to learn, allow you and your teachers to predict your future attainment and may be used as the basis of information for Exceptional Circumstances Requests or as part of the evidence for an estimate in the event of cancellation of exams.

It is therefore expected that conduct during all assessments is of the highest standard, allowing all students to demonstrate their maximum level of performance.

Formal Assessment Period

- The Formal assessment period will run from Monday 8TH January to Monday 15th January inclusive.
- When not doing an assessment, you must attend class as per your timetable.
- College courses will continue to run as normal and you MUST attend.
- You must wear school uniform whenever you are in the school building and for all assessments.
- Ensure you have a study plan and are prepared for your exams By failing to prepare you are
 preparing to fail!
- Make sure that you know when and where your assessments are taking place.

Expectations for all assessments

- Teacher/Invigilator instructions must be followed at all times.
- Any pupil behaving in an inappropriate manner for example, talking, turning round, failing to follow instructions will be asked to leave the assessment room.
