As pupils progress through the school our excursion approach ensures progression in key skills listed below.

Alongside our Skills in Action course in S1 and S2, pupils are continually assessing their mastery of the Skills Development Scotland Meta-Skills. By the end of S2 they will have a Level 3 Dynamic Youth Award. Our excursions allow students put skills developed in the curriculum into action. In S3 pupils are actively collaborating with staff to shape their Exodus experience and the skills they develop will empower them to further successes in the senior school culminating with a level 6 Leadership award in S6. This focus on the SDS Meta-Skills will allows pupils to track their progress into the senior school and beyond.
